In a Landslide, 25-Year-Old Alex Lee Declares Victory in California's Assembly District 25, Breaking Multiple Records

SAN JOSÉ, CA – With 100% percent of precincts reporting in Alameda and Santa Clara counties and approximately 104,000 of votes counted, 25-year old Alex Lee's grassroots campaign for State Assembly has declared victory. In a historic victory, Alex is the youngest Asian American, first openly bisexual, and first Gen-Z Legislator in California history.

"I'm deeply grateful to the diverse communities of Assembly District 25," said Lee. "The significance of our victory is part of a bigger, progressive movement ready to fight for a better future for all of us."

After beating seven other Democrats and advancing from the March primary to defeat a Republican opponent, Lee's campaign gained a significant boost after receiving endorsements from U.S. Senator **Bernie Sanders**, former presidential candidate **Andrew Yang**, as well as over a hundred local leaders and organizations.

"When we announced our campaign last June, we were the underdog," said Lee. "And with this victory, we're challenging the status quo. We're proof that if you have a dream and you fight for it, you can get there. Despite being outspent 15 to 1 in the primary, our commitment to running a clean money campaign, our focus on the community, and our clear vision for the future is what resonated with people."

Alex is a graduate of Milpitas High School and UC Davis, where he served as Student Body President. Previously, he has worked for California State Senator Henry Stern in Sacramento and Assemblymember Evan Low.

Lee will represent the 25th Assembly District encompassing Fremont, San José, Santa Clara, Milpitas, and Newark.
